Abstract / Content summary	The average consumption of protein foods in Papua New Guinea (PNG) remains insufficient to meet nutritious diet guidelines. This study examined the constraints facing rural poultry production in PNG. The constraints were categorized into three groups: production, market, and policy. Production constraints included low productivity, lack of access to markets, and lack of extension services. Market constraints included high costs of inputs, low prices, and lack of infrastructure. Policy constraints included lack of clear policies, lack of investment in agriculture, and lack of support for small-scale farmers. The findings suggest that addressing these constraints could improve rural poultry production and contribute to improved nutrition in PNG.
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
