Abstract / Content summary	Small livestock, pig and poultry particularly, have prehistorically been an integral part of human habitation and transmigration in Papua New Guinea. They are important sources of protein and income for rural households, and play a key role in the local economy. However, the sector is facing significant challenges, including disease, climate change, and market access. This study aims to assess the value chain of small livestock in Papua New Guinea, identify key actors and value-added activities, and provide recommendations for improving the sector's resilience and sustainability.
